



SHOW ETIQUETTE AND STABLE RULES

- 1) Please help keep things clean and tidy by picking up after oneself.
- 2) Please keep dressing room and tack room clean and organized.
- 3) No one except Trainer's and Caretaker's are to enter working ready room. If you need anything out of them please ask one of the Trainer's or Caretaker's and they will get what you need.
- 4) No one is to take anything out of or from work ready room without first obtaining permission from one of the Trainer's or Caretaker's.
- 5) If you borrow anything from Corbett Stables please return item or items promptly after use to one of the Trainer's Caretaker's.
- 6) When one's horse is in full care please stay away from the ready room when Caretaker's are getting horse ready, the process goes a lot quicker and easier when there are no distractions.
- 7) Please inform the Trainer's prior to the beginning of the show what classes you are participating in if they do not already know so they can mark it on their class list and let the Caretaker's know.
- 8) Please be in the stable area at least three classes prior to your class so you are not rushing to get to the arena. It helps make the day and performance run easier and less stressful on the Trainer's and Caretaker's.
- 9) If on full care and you want anything done to or on your horse ask or tell one of the Trainer's and they will do it or relay it to one of the Caretaker's to get it done. Please go through one of the Trainer's, it helps keep the grooms in better moods and focused on doing their job if not being bothered.
- 10) Horses at show that are in training will be warmed up by Trainer prior to owner getting on when needed.
- 11) Please keep horses in their stalls. If you do remove horse from stall please notify trainer first.
- 12) Tipping of Grooms and Caretaker's strongly encouraged! They work long hard days for you, giving your Horse the highest care possible, show them the appreciation they deserve. You tip Waiters and Waitresses for doing 1/8 the work our grooms do for you!
- 13) Alcohol and Alcoholic beverages are permitted but please be discrete about it and keep an eye on any adult beverages brought to shows due to the number of juvenal exhibitors who may be tempted to experiment.
- 14) Always show good sportsmanship no matter the out come and have fun! Remember, Your behavior and actions reflects on Corbett Stables.
